DAILY ORDER

1. The above matter was kept for hearing on 25.06.2025.
2. At the outset, it was informed by the Commission that previously the main matter was heard by full bench of the Commission on 03.03.2025 and the Commission vide Daily Order dated 15.04.2025 has reserved Order in the main matter. Thereafter, the Applicant/Petitioner has filed

IA No. 45 of 2025 in the present matter seeking some interim reliefs from the Commission. The then Hon'ble Chairman on office file has decided that the present IA is to be taken up by the two Hon'ble Members of the Commission. Accordingly, the present IA has been kept for hearing. In response to the same, Ld. Adv. Mr. Yash Dahich, appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner, submitted that the present IA No. 45 of 2025 in main Petition is filed seeking interim relief to stay the operation of the letter dated 17.05.2025 issued by GUVNL so that no coercive action may be taken by the Respondents against the Applicant/Petitioner during the pendency of present Petition. He submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner has undertaken various steps to expedite timely completion of the project in order to mitigate the delay in execution of the project. He also submitted that Applicant/Petitioner has commissioned 82.5 MW out of 140 MW on 19.03.2025. He submitted that during the pendency of present Petition, the Applicant/Petitioner has received a letter dated 17.05.2025 from GUVNL wherein GUVNL intimated the Applicant/Petitioner that the maximum deadline for commissioning of the full capacity with applicable penalty is, upto 12.06.2025. He further submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner has commissioned the balance capacity of the plant on 11.06.2025. Hence, the present IA No. 45 of 2025 became infructuous and the same may be disposed of.

- 2.1. He further submitted that earlier coram of the Commission has heard the matter consists of the then Chairman and the present two Members, however, today only two members are available for hearing due to retirement of the then Chairman.
3. Ld. Adv. Ms. Shrishti Khindaria, appearing on behalf of the Respondents GUVNL and GETCO addressed the Applicant/Petitioner submissions. She submitted that the Commission may hear the main matter.

4. We have considered the submissions made by the parties. We note that the Applicant/Petitioner has filed the present IA being IA No. 45 of 2025 in Petition No. 2314 of 2024 seeking interim relief to grant the stay in the operation of the letter dated 17.05.2025 issued by GUVNL to prevent the Respondents to take any coercive action against the Applicant/Petitioner during the pendency of present Petition. The Applicant/Petitioner has submitted that a letter dated 17.05.2025 from GUVNL wherein the maximum deadline for commissioning of the full capacity with applicable penalty is, upto 12.06.2025 received by it but the Applicant/Petitioner has commissioned the balance capacity of the plant on 11.06.2025. Hence, the present IA does not survive as it became infructuous and accordingly stands disposed of.
- 4.1. We further note that the main matter was heard by the Coram of the Commission consists of the then Hon'ble Chairman and both present the Members and thereafter, the present IA is filed in Petition No. 2314 of 2024. We also note that during the hearing on 25.06.2025, the counsels for the Petitioner and the Respondent submitted that the Commission may hear the main matter.
5. Order accordingly.
