ORDER

1. This Petition has been filed by the Petitioners GUVNL alongwith MGCVCL, UGVCL, PGVCL & DGVCL as Co-Petitioners, *interalia*, seeking approval of the mechanism for applicable tariff for purchase of power from solar project capacity above 0.5 MW & upto 4.0 MW and Wind Project capacity above 0.5 MW and less than 10 MW and also to approve draft Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) to be executed under the Gujarat Renewable Energy Policy, 2023.
2. The Petitioner *interalia* seeking following prayers:
 - a) *To admit the petition.*
 - b) *To approval the mechanism of applicable tariff for purchase of power from solar projects above 0.5 MW upto 4.0 MW and Wind Projects above 0.5 MW to less than 10 MW under the Gujarat Renewable Energy Policy, 2023 as stated in para 14 of the Petition.*
 - c) *To approve the signing of PPA for the Solar Project above 0.5 MW upto 4.0 MW with Solar Project developers under distributed RE bilateral purchase under the Gujarat Renewable Energy Policy, 2023 in accordance with the provision of approved mechanism by the Commission vide Order in Petition No. 1802 of 2019 pending the issuance of the relevant order for approval of tariff determination mechanism under Gujarat Renewable Energy Policy, 2023.*
 - d) *To approve draft Standard Operating procedure (SOP) annexed with the Petition.*
 - e) *To approve Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) annexed with the Petition.*
 - f) *The Petitioners craves leave of the Hon'ble Commission to allow further*

submissions, prayers, additions and alterations to this Petition as may be necessary from time to time.

g) Pass any other order (s) as the Commission may deem just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

3. The matter was listed for hearing on 13.01.2026. During the hearing, Ms. M.N. Gajjar, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner GUVNL, submitted that the Petitioners have filed the present Petition seeking approval of the mechanism of applicable tariff for purchase of power from solar project capacity above 0.5 MW & upto 4.0 MW and Wind Project capacity above 0.5 MW & less than 10 MW as well as draft PPA under the Gujarat Renewable Energy Policy, 2023. The matter was earlier heard on 28.06.2024 and as per the directives of the Commission vide its Daily Order dated 08.08.2024, the Petitioner GUVNL filed compliance affidavit dated 14.10.2024 stating that the Petitioner GUVNL issued public notice on 31.08.2024 and invited the comments/suggestions/objections from the stakeholders in the matter. It is further submitted that in the meantime, the Commission issued the Wind Tariff Order No. 05 of 2024 and Solar Tariff Order No. 06 of 2024 on 31.08.2024 providing the tariff framework for Procurement of Power by Distribution licensees and Others from Solar Power Projects and Wind Power Projects respectively for State of Gujarat. Therefore, the tariff orders providing for tariff frameworks for Wind Power Projects and Solar Power Projects are already issued by the Commission, the Petitioners has filed an affidavit seeking permission of the Commission for withdrawing the present Petition unconditionally as the Petitioners are no longer required to pursue the present Petition. Accordingly, it is requested to the Commission to permit unconditional withdrawal of Petition.
4. Heard the parties. We note that during the hearing on 13.01.2026, the representative appearing on behalf of the Petitioner GUVNL submitted that

the Petitioner has filed an affidavit dated 14.10.2024 in the matter seeking for withdrawal of the present Petition as the Commission has already issued Orders on tariff framework, viz., (i) Wind Tariff Order No. 05 of 2024 and (ii) Solar Tariff Order on 31.08.2024. In view of this, we allow Petitioner to unconditionally withdraw the Petition No. 2350 of 2025.

5. Accordingly, this Petition stand dismissed and disposed off as unconditional withdrawn by the Petitioner GUVNL.

6. Order accordingly.
