**DAILY ORDER**

1. The matter is kept for hearing on 17.07.2025.

2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj appearing for the Respondent submitted that they have not received the copy of the Petition from the Petitioner, hence once the Petition is received by them the Respondent needs time to file its reply in the matter.
3. Ld. Adv. appearing for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition is filed by the Petitioner to waive off HT bill from the month of June 2024 to October 2024 and allow grace period to start billing from December 2024 and to Phase wise load requirement for NMHC (National Maritime Heritage Complex) Lothal Project at Village Saragwala, Tal: Dholka, District Ahmedabad.
