DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 07.04.2026.

2. Ld. Adv. Ms. Nipun Sharma, appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner, submitted that the counsel for Applicant/Petitioner has circulated a letter for requesting the adjournment in the matter for filing its rejoinder reply to the Respondent's reply dated 10.12.2025, to the additional affidavit dated 02.09.2025 filed by the Applicant/Petitioner. Accordingly, she requested the Commission to grant two weeks' time to the Applicant/Petitioner for filing its rejoinder reply in the matter and requested to list the matter for hearing thereafter.
