ORDER

1. The present Petition has been filed by the Petitioner seeking condonation of delay in submission of Tariff Petition in the matter of Truing up of FY 2023-24 based on GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2016 and the MYT Petition of Approval of ARR for the 4th Control Period i.e. from FY 2025-26 to FY 2029-30 and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26 in accordance with the GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2024.
2. The facts mentioned in petition in brief are as under:
 - 2.1 M/s Jubilant Infrastructure Limited (JIL) submitted that it has commenced its operation as a Distribution Licensee on August 26, 2023, in line with GERC Order.

It is still in the initial stages as a Distribution Licensee and is working diligently to establish.

2.2 Shri Mukesh Pal on behalf of the Petitioner has submitted that due to the process of separation and the preparation of the annual accounts for the Financial year 2023-24, there has been an unavoidable delay in the filing of the True up Petition.

2.3 By considering the above facts and circumstances, he requested the Commission to condone the delay in filing the tariff petition in the matter of Truing up of FY 2023-24 and the MYT Petition of Approval of ARR for the 4th Control Period i.e. from FY 2025-26 to FY 2029-30 and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26.

3 Heard and considered the petitioner's submission.

4 We observe that Clause 25.11 in the GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2024 has stipulated that the Petitioner shall file its MYT Petition, Mid-Term Review petition and/or Truing-up petition, as may be applicable, by 30th November of the year in which it is required to be filed in accordance with afore-said Regulations.

5 We further observe that M/s JIL vide letter dtd. 21.11.2024 requested the Commission to grant extension in filing the tariff MYT Petition till 31st January, 2025 citing certain specific reasons.

6 We note that M/s JIL has been granted extension and further directed to file a separate application for condonation of delay stating the reasons along with the Tariff Petition for Truing up of FY 2023-24 and the MYT Petition for the 4th Control Period.

7 We further note that in Compliance to the afore-said direction, M/s JIL filed a separate application for condonation of delay with necessary fees along with the Tariff Petition in the matter of Truing up of FY 2023-24 based on GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2016 and the MYT Petition of Approval of ARR for the 4th Control Period i.e. from FY 2025-26 to FY 2029-30 and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26 in accordance with the GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2024.

8 Now, the Petitioner has submitted the present Petition seeking condonation of delay in submitting Tariff Petition in the matter of Truing up of FY 2023-24 based on GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2016 and the MYT Petition of Approval of ARR for the 4th Control Period i.e. from FY 2025-26 to FY 2029-30 and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26 in accordance with the GERC (MYT) Regulations, 2024 for the reasons as cited in foregoing paras. We are of the view that the process of tariff determination involves various financial, technical, and legal aspects is a very complex and detailed process. Considering the above, we allow delay condonation and disposed of this petition as allowed.
