DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 06.01.2026.

2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner GETCO, submitted that the present Petition has been filed by the Applicant/Petitioner seeking for amendment in provisions of the Order No. 01 of 2024 dated 22.02.2024 with regard to the timelines provided for completion and commissioning of evacuation infrastructures and RE capacity. He stated that under Sections 61, 64 and 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission has jurisdiction and authority to entertain the present Petition for amendment of Order No. 1 of 2024 dated 22.02.2024 in view of various difficulties faced by RE developers in completion and commissioning of evacuation infrastructures and RE capacity within the timelines specified in the Order.
 - 2.1. He further submitted that in the Daily Order dated 12.11.2025 passed by the Commission in present Petition, the directions were given to the Petitioner for inviting comments/suggestions/objections from the stakeholders by issuing public notices in newspaper and accordingly, in compliance thereof, the Petitioner has published the same in 'Times of India in English Daily and in 'Divya Bhaskar' Daily on 11.12.2025 in Gujarati Language, both having wide circulation in the State and also uploaded the copy of the Petition on its website for inviting the objections and suggestions from the stakeholders. Moreover, the Petitioner has also filed compliance affidavit dated 02.01.2026 in this regard before the Commission on 03.01.2026. As such, he completed the arguments and made the submissions in the matter.
3. Mr. Ashu Gupta, appearing for the Respondent No. 11, has supported the present Petition and made the submissions in the matter.
 - 3.1. The representative appearing for the Respondent No. 19, the representative appearing for the Respondent No. 25 and Ld. Adv.

appearing for the Respondent No. 34 have adopted the submissions made by the Respondent No. 11 and completed their submissions in the matter.

3.2. Mr. Jignesh Langalia, appearing for the Respondent No. 5 Torrent Power Limited (TPL), supported the present Petition and also made the submissions in the matter.

3.3. Ld. Adv. Ms. Shreya Dubey, appearing for the Respondent No. 17 has concluded the submissions in the matter. She requested the Commission to allow one week' time to file written submissions on affidavit in the matter.

3.4. Mr. Siddharth Richhariya, appearing for the Respondent No. 21, Vena Energy submitted that the Respondent has already filed their comments/suggestions in the matter and requested the Commission to consider the same while deciding the present matter.

3.5. Mr. Parthiv Dave appearing as an Objector in the present matter submitted that today they have filed the objections/comments in the matter and requested the Commission to consider the same while deciding the present matter.

4. Heard the Parties. We note that when the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Respondents except Respondents No. 4,5,11,17,19,21,25,32, & 34 although the hearing notice was issued to them by post and through email as well. We note that the aforesaid Respondents neither remained present during today's proceedings nor made any written communication about their inability to remain present, despite being served the hearing notice to them.

4.1. We note that pursuant to directives of the Commission in Daily Order dated 12.11.2025, the Petitioner has published the public notices and also uploaded the Petition on its website for inviting comments/objections/suggestions from the stakeholders in the present Petition. We also note that the Petitioner has filed compliance affidavit dated 02.01.2026 for the same before the Commission on 03.01.2026.

4.2. We note that the Applicant/Petitioner and the Respondents/Objectors have concluded their submissions in the matter. As the Ld. Adv. For the Respondent No. 17 has sought time to file its written submission on affidavit, let the same be filed, if any, within 3 days from the date of hearing. The matter is now reserved for appropriate Order.
