DAILY ORDER

1. The above matter was listed for hearing on 19.08.2025.
2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner GETCO, submitted that the present Petition has been filed for seeking amendment of Orders No. 01 of 2024 dated 22.02.2024, 05 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 and 06 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 passed by the Commission. In response to query of the Commission, he submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner will amend the present Petition limiting its prayers with respect to seeking initiation of proceedings for amendment of Order No. 01 of 2024, whereas, for other Orders, viz., Orders No. 05 of 2024 & 06 of 2024 the

Applicant/Petitioner GETCO will file separate petitions seeking initiation of proceedings for amendments of the aforesaid Orders. He requested the Commission to grant some time to the Applicant/Petitioner in the matter.

3. When the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Respondents No. 3 to 10 although the hearing notice was issued to them by post. We note that the aforesaid Respondents neither remained present during today's proceedings nor made any written communication about their inability to remain present, despite being served the hearing notice to them.
4. We note that the Applicant/Petitioner GETCO has filed the present Petition collectively seeking initiation of proceedings for amendment of various RE Tariff Orders, viz., Orders No. 01 of 2024 dated 22.02.2024 pertains to "*Tariff Framework for Procurement of Power by Distribution Licensees and Others from Wind-Solar Hybrid Projects including Storage, if any, and Other Commercial Issues for the State of Gujarat*", 05 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 pertains to "*Tariff Framework for Procurement of Power by Distribution licensees and Others from Wind Power Projects for State of Gujarat*", and 06 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 pertains to "*Tariff Framework for Procurement of Power by Distribution licensees and Others from Solar Power Projects for State of Gujarat*" passed by the Commission. The Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner admitted that all the above three RE Tariff Orders of the Commission are different and distinct from each other. He agreed to file separate Petition for other two RE Tariff Orders by continuing one RE Tariff Order for present Petition. We further note that the Ld. Counsel for the Applicant/Petitioner has agreed to amend the present Petition, limiting its prayers with respect to seeking initiation of proceedings for

amendment of Order No. 01 of 2024 and to file separate petitions seeking initiation of proceedings for amendment of the Orders No. 05 of 2024 & 06 of 2024. Accordingly, let the Applicant/Petitioner GETCO to amend the present Petition in accordance with law and to file amended Petition and to provide a copy of amended Petition along with all other documents to all the Respondents within three weeks' time from the date of this Order and to file proof of service in this regard.

5. We note that none of the Respondents, i.e. distribution licensees have not filed their reply in the present Petition. We, therefore, direct all the distribution licensees to file their respective reply, if any, within three weeks' time, after receipt of the amended Petition from the Applicant/Petitioner, with a copy to them. The Applicant/Petitioner is also at liberty to file its rejoinder reply, if any, within two weeks' time with a copy to the Respondents after receipt of reply from the Respondents. The Applicant/Petitioner would also be at liberty to file separate petitions seeking initiation of proceedings for amendments of the Order No. 05 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 & Order No. 06 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024.
6. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
7. Order accordingly.
