## **DAILY ORDER**

1. The matter was listed for hearing on 21.05.2026.
2. At the outset, Mr. Shubhadeep Sen appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the Respondent GUVNL has filed its Reply in the matter and copy of the same is served to the Petitioner today itself. He requested the Commission to grant two weeks to file its Rejoinder reply to the Reply filed by the Respondent GUVNL.
  - 2.1. He further submitted that the Petitioner has already commenced the supply of energy, to the Respondent GUVNL from its Solar Power Project, however, the Petitioner is not getting any payment towards the such supply in absence of the tariff to be determined by the Commission in the present matter and it is likely that the entire process of tariff determination may take some time as Respondent GUVNL has recently filed its Reply in the present matter. Accordingly, he requested the Commission to grant liberty to the Petitioner to file appropriate IA for grant of provisional tariff as an interim relief subject to determination of Final Tariff by the Commission.
3. Mr. K. N. Bhrahmbhatt, appearing for the Respondent GUNVL submitted that the Respondent has filed its Reply in the matter. It is further submitted that the Respondent is having no objection to the adjournment sought by the Petitioner for filing its Rejoinder reply in the matter.
4. Heard the parties. We note that the Petitioner has sought time to file its Rejoinder reply to the reply filed by the Respondent GUVNL, let it be filed within two weeks from the date of this Order. Further, the

Petitioner shall have liberty to file appropriate IA, if any, in the matter in accordance with law, within two weeks with a copy to the Respondent GUVNL.

5. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
6. Order accordingly.
