DAILY ORDER

1. The present matter was kept for hearing on 12.05.2026.
2. Ld. Adv. Mr. Aditya Singh, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted that the present Petition is filed by the Petitioner seeking extension of the Scheduled Date of Commissioning of its Solar project in terms of PPA dated 17.08.2022 pursuant to occurrence of various force majeure events and circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Petitioner which have impacted implementation of the project and seeking refund of the amount of liquidated damages paid to the Respondent GUVNL.

- 2.1. He submitted that, pursuant to the last Daily Order dated 18.10.2025, the Respondents were directed to file their reply within four weeks; however, the same has been filed only today. He further submitted that the Petitioner may be granted time to file its rejoinder in the matter for which four weeks sought for.
3. In response to the above submission of the Petitioner, the Ld. Adv. Ms. Aishwariya Subramani appearing on behalf of the Respondent, submitted that there is no objection to the adjournment sought by the Petitioner.
4. Heard the parties. Considering the request of the Petitioner to adjourn the present matter for filing its rejoinder reply in the matter and the Respondent having no objection to the same, the matter stands adjourned. We direct the Petitioner to file its rejoinder reply in accordance with law, with a copy to the Respondent, invariably within four weeks' time, from the date of this Order. The Respondent would be at liberty to file their submission, if any, within 10 days' time invariably after receipt of the rejoinder reply from the Petitioner with a copy to them.
5. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
