Daily Order

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 13.10.2025.
2. Ld. Adv. Mr. Aniket Prasoon, appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner, submitted that the present Petition is filed by the Applicant/Petitioner seeking direction of the Commission to the Respondent to return the bank guarantee of Rs. 20 Lakhs to the Applicant/Petitioner which was initially given by the Applicant/Petitioner for availing the connectivity of 200 MW at 220 KV Kapadwanj Substation of the Respondent GETCO. He also submitted that the Commission to issue direction to the Respondent GETCO for refund of bay estimate charges paid by the Applicant/Petitioner in relation to the said connectivity.
3. Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Respondent GETCO, requested for adjournment of this matter and submitted that the Commission may give four weeks' time to the Respondent GETCO to file its reply in the matter and thereafter post the matter for hearing on any date subject to the convenience of the Commission.
4. In response to the above submissions of GECTO, the counsel appearing for the Applicant/Petitioner submitted that there is no objection to the adjournment sought by the Respondent. It is requested that the

Commission may also grant some time to the Applicant/Petitioner to file rejoinder reply in the matter and also agreed to post the matter for hearing on any date subject to the convenience of the Commission.

5. Considering the request of the Respondent for the adjournment in the present matter and there is no objection to the same by the Applicant/Petitioner, the matter is adjourned. We also note that the Ld. Counsel of the Respondent requested for time to file reply in the matter. Let the same be filed within four weeks' time from the date of this Order with a copy to the Applicant/Petitioner. The Applicant/Petitioner would be at liberty to file their rejoinder reply, if any, within 10 days' time after receipt of reply from the Respondent with a copy to them.
6. We also note that the Petitioner has filed IA being IA No. 90 of 2025 in the present Petition seeking urgent listing of Petition No. 2547 of 2025. Since, the Commission has taken up the main matter, the prayer in I.A. No. 90 of 2025 filed for seeking urgent listing of Petition No. 2547 of 2025 is satisfied. Accordingly, I.A. No. 90 of 2025 stands disposed of.
7. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
8. Order accordingly.
