DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 06.01.2026.
2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner GETCO, submitted that the present Petition has been filed by the Petitioner seeking for amendment in provisions of the Order No. 05 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 with regard to the timelines provided for completion and commissioning of evacuation infrastructures and RE capacity. He stated that under Sections 61, 64 and 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission has jurisdiction and authority to entertain the present Petition for amendment of Order No. 05 of 2024 dated 31.08.2024 in view of various difficulties faced by RE developers in completion and commissioning of evacuation infrastructures and RE capacity within the timelines specified in the Order.
 - 2.1. He further submitted that in the Daily Order dated 12.11.2025 passed by the Commission in present Petition, the directions were given to the Petitioner for inviting comments/suggestions/objections from the stakeholders by issuing public notices in newspaper and accordingly, in compliance thereof, the Petitioner has published the same in 'Times of India in English Daily and in 'Divya Bhaskar' Daily on 11.12.2025 in Gujarati Language, both having wide circulation in the State and also uploaded the copy of the Petition on its website for inviting the objections and suggestions from the stakeholders in the present

Petition. Moreover, the Petitioner has also filed compliance affidavit dated 02.01.2026 in this regard before the Commission on 03.01.2026. As such, he completed the arguments and made the submissions in the matter.

3. The representatives for Respondents who appeared in Petition No. 2390 of 2025 which is listed today, submitted that the subject matter of the present Petition No. 2363 of 2025 is in identical nature to the Petition No. 2390 of 2025 for which they have already made elaborate submissions and concluded arguments. As such, they requested the Commission to consider the same while deciding the present matter.

3.1. Mr. Parthiv Dave appearing as an Objector in the present matter submitted that today they have filed the objections/comments in the matter and requested the Commission to consider the same while deciding the present matter.

4. Heard the Parties. We note that when the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Respondents except Respondents No. 4,5,13,14 & 15 although the hearing notice was issued to them by post and through email as well. We note that the aforesaid Respondents neither remained present during today's proceedings nor made any written communication about their inability to remain present, despite being served the hearing notice to them.

4.1. We note that pursuant to directives of the Commission in Daily Order dated 12.11.2025, the Petitioner has published the public notices and also uploaded the Petition on its website for inviting comments/objections/suggestions from the stakeholders in the present Petition. We also note that the Petitioner has filed compliance

affidavit dated 02.01.2026 for the same before the Commission on 03.01.2026.

4.2. We note that the Petitioner and the Respondents/Objectors have concluded their submissions in the matter. The matter is now reserved for appropriate Order.
