DAILY ORDER

1. The present matter was kept for hearing on 15.04.2026.
2. Mr. A. H. Talsaniya, representative appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted that the MNRE has withdrawn the allocation to the State of Gujarat under KUSUM-A Scheme vide its letter dated 03.02.2026. He submitted that the Petitioner has requested MNRE to review the decision and restore the allocated capacity so that the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) can be executed with the successful bidders under KUSUM-A

Scheme. He submitted that the Petitioner is in touch with MNRE and presently awaiting a response from MNRE and it is likely that the MNRE may review the decision and restore the allocated capacity. Therefore, based on the decision of MNRE with regard to allocation of capacity, the Petitioner will be in a position to process the execution of the PPA.

3. In response to the query of the Commission regarding the expected timeline for receiving clarification from MNRE and whether the Petitioner wants to proceed without Performance Based Incentive (PBI) and allocation, the representative appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner is awaiting MNRE's reply regarding allocation of capacity. He requested the Commission that while granting the adjournment, may also grant two weeks' time to the Petitioner to place on record the response received from MNRE and further submissions based on such restore, if any, in the matter.
4. Heard the Petitioner PGVCL. Considering the request made by the Petitioner PGVCL seeking for adjournment, the matter stands adjourned. As recorded in para 3 above, the Petitioner is directed to file further submissions, within two weeks' time from the date of this Order.
5. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
6. Order accordingly.
