**DAILY ORDER**

1. The present matter was kept for hearing on 15.04.2026.

2. Mr. N.K. Tejot, representative appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner UGVCL, submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner has filed IA No. 12 of 2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026 *inter alia* seeking following prayers:

*(a) admit the present Application.*

*(b) Take the corrected tables on record for Pages 14-16 and 18 of the Petition and Page 501-503 of the Additional Submissions.*

*(c) Correct and rectify the error in the Order dated 21.02.2026 passed by this Hon'ble Commission to the extent stated herein; and*

*(d) Pass such further order or orders as this Hon'ble Commission may deem just and proper in the circumstances of the case.*

2.1. He submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner has filed the present Application seeking correction and amendment of information in the Petition, as well as correction, rectification, and clarification of the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026. He submitted that in the Petition, the Applicant/Petitioner had provided the details of the bidding process and evaluation thereof, including, *inter-alia*, the lowest tariff rates offered by the respective bidders in ascending order and the final ranking for selection of bidders. Further, pursuant to the Daily Order dated 19.01.2026, the Petitioner filed Additional Submissions on 20.01.2026 wherein the Applicant/Petitioner has furnished a table as per the Petition with an additional column indicating the "Acceptable Tariff after 31.12.2025," derived on account of the non-availability of MNRE' PBI as per Office Memorandum dated 31.12.2025. However, it is submitted that there is an inadvertent errors, accidental slips, and typographical errors in the tables at Pages 14–16 of the Petition and Pages 501–503 of the Additional Submissions, particularly with respect to tariff rates, rankings of bidders, and reverse auction IDs in respect of certain bidders. He further submitted that in view of this, there is a consequential change in the names of persons/entities to be considered as successful bidders, and accordingly, the table at Page 18 of the

Petition is required to be revised. It is also submitted that due to the aforesaid inadvertent errors, the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 contains inaccuracies with regard to the entities having discovered tariff lower than Rs. 2.87 per unit, as recorded in Paragraphs 2.8 and 3.1 of the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026. The Petitioner has provided the corrected table as follows:

2.2. Based on the above, he requested the Commission to allow the correction and rectification of the tables contained in the Petition and in the submissions of the Applicant/Petitioner, as well as correction of the consequential errors crept in the Order dated 21.02.2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026. He further submitted that the proposed corrections do not alter the merits of the matter, and continues to pertain to bidders quoting tariff lower than Rs. 2.87 per unit. There is no dispute or controversy with respect to the tariff rates or RA IDs; the rankings are based on clear and undisputed factual aspects. He submitted that the present amendment, correction, and rectification are necessary for proper adjudication and for arriving at a just decision with respect to adoption of tariff and grant of approval.

- 2.3. He further submitted that the MNRE has withdrawn the allocation to the State of Gujarat under KUSUM-A Scheme vide its letter dated 03.02.2026. He submitted that the Petitioner has requested MNRE to review the decision and restore the allocated capacity so that the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) can be executed with the successful bidders under KUSUM-A Scheme. He submitted that the Petitioner is in touch with MNRE and presently awaiting a response from MNRE and it is likely that the MNRE may review the decision and restore the allocated capacity. Therefore, based on the decision of MNRE with regard to allocation of capacity, the Petitioner will be in a position to process the execution of the PPA.
- 2.4. In response to the query of the Commission regarding the expected timeline for receiving clarification from MNRE and whether the Petitioner wants to proceed without Performance Based Incentive (PBI) and allocation, the representative appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner is awaiting MNRE's reply regarding allocation of capacity. He requested the Commission that while granting the adjournment, may also grant two weeks' time to the Petitioner to place on record the response received from MNRE and further submissions based on such restore, if any, in the matter.
3. Heard the Parties. We have considered the submission made by the Applicant/Petitioner UGVCL. We note that the Applicant/Petitioner has filed IA No. 12 of 2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026 seeking correction and rectification of the Petition and the Order dated 21.02.2026.
- 3.1. We note the submission of the Applicant/ Petitioner that inadvertent mistakes have been identified in the tables at Pages 14-16 and Page 18 of the Petition, as well as Pages 501-503 of the Additional Submissions, particularly concerning tariff rates, rankings, and RA IDs.

3.2. We note the submission of the Applicant/ Petitioner that due to these errors, inaccuracies have occurred with regard to the entities with discovered tariff lower than Rs. 2.87 per unit in para 2.8 and para 3.1 of the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026. Therefore, it is necessary to refer the relevant para of Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 which is reproduced below:

3.3. We further note that on account of inadvertent errors identified by the Applicant/Petitioner in the tables at Pages 14–16 and Page 18 of the Petition and Pages 501–503 of the Additional Submissions, certain inaccuracies have occurred in respect of entities having discovered tariff lower than Rs. 2.87 per unit, as recorded in Paragraphs 2.8. and 3.1. of the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 in Petition No. 2602 of 2026. We, therefore, decide to substitute the said para 2.8. and 3.1. of the Daily Order dated 21.02.2026 as under:

- 3.6. Considering the request made by the Petitioner UGVCL seeking for adjournment, the matter stands adjourned. As recorded in para 2.4 above, the Petitioner is directed to file further submissions, within two weeks' time from the date of this Order.
