

DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 26.06.2025.
2. Ld. Sr. Adv. Mr. Saurabh Soparkar appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted its submissions in detail and completed its arguments in the present Petition.
3. Ld. Adv. Aneesh Bajaj appearing for the Respondent GUVNL also submitted its submissions in detail and completed its arguments. He submitted that the Petitioner has not provided certain details.
4. Despite of hearing notice being served to the Objector through RPAD and email, nobody neither appeared nor intimated its inability to appear during the hearing.
5. On the query of the Commission whether the following documents as to whether filed by the Petitioner or not:

- 
- (i) Information memorandum prepared by the Resolution professional containing relevant and vital information related to Petitioner company and to the prospective resolution Applicants.
 - (ii) Deed of confirmation for handing over physical possession by the Resolution professional to the Petitioner company.
 - (iii) Resolution Plan proposal invited from the bidder by the Resolution professional
 - (iv) The Bid submitted by the petitioner against such proposal of Resolution Professional by the petitioner.
 - (v) Decision of Committee of Creditors on the Recommendation of Resolution professional and Bidder bids.
 - (vi) Orders of NCLT, NCLAT and higher forums.
 - (vii) With regard to water-logging due to heavy rainfall, it is necessary contour report of the project site clearly depicting water logging areas, natural flow of rain water, levelling of site by land filling with consideration and arrangement made to avoid any water logging while preparing /levelling the site for setting up the project carried out by the Petitioner before installation and commissioning of the plant by the petitioner.
 - (viii) Technical specification sheet/ data of the Modules/ inverter as per manufacturer.
 - (ix) Any other details.

6. In response to above, Ld. Sr. Advocate for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner would provide the above details available with it.

7. Heard the parties. We note that the parties have argued at length and completed their submissions in the matter. We also take note that the Objector neither remained present nor intimated its inability to remain

present during the hearing. The parties are at liberty to file their further submissions, if any, within four weeks' time.

8. We also note that the various documents/ details need to provide by the Petitioner as stated in Para 5 above. The Petitioner agreed to provide the same. Hence, we direct the Petitioner to provide the same within 4 weeks with a copy to the Respondents.

9. The matter is kept for hearing on 19.08.2025 at 11.30 Hrs. on documents and issues if any.

10. We Order accordingly.
