Daily Order

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 27.05.2025.
2. Ld. Adv. Mr. Mridul Chakravarty, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted that the present Petition is filed by the Petitioner seeking extension of the Scheduled Date of Commissioning of infrastructure being developed by the Petitioner for evacuation of power from its 40 MW Hybrid Power Plant to the Respondent GETCO's 66 kV

Sutrapada Sub-Station on account of occurrences and circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Petitioner being unforeseen events or reasons.

3. Ld. Adv. Mr. Aneesh Bajaj, appearing on behalf of the Respondent GETCO, submitted that the Commission while granting adjournment may also give two weeks' time to the Respondent GETCO to file its reply in the matter and thereafter post the matter for hearing on any date subject to the convenience of the Commission.
4. In response to the above submissions of GETCO, the counsel appearing for the Petitioner submitted that there is no objection to the adjournment sought by the Respondent. It is requested that the Commission may also grant some time to the Petitioner to file rejoinder reply in the matter and also agreed to post the matter for hearing on any date subject to the convenience of the Commission.
5. Considering the request of the Respondent for the adjournment in the present matter and there is no objection to the same by the Petitioner, the matter is adjourned. We also note that the Ld. Counsel of the Respondent requested for time to file reply in the matter. Let the same be filed within two weeks' time from the date of the hearing with a copy to the Petitioner. The Petitioner would be at liberty to file their rejoinder reply, if any, within 10 days' time after receipt of reply from the Respondent with a copy to them.
6. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
