DAILY ORDER

1. The present matter was listed for hearing on 04.10.2025.
2. Ld. Adv. Ms. Kiran Joshi appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner is seeking for extension of time for grid connectivity and commissioning for 90 days in respect of aggregate 7.8 MW solar power plants developed at two different sites. She further submitted that the project of the Petitioner is ready for commissioning and the Petitioner is waiting for allocation of Sr. No. of ABT meter by SLDC and after receipt of the same the meter will be manufactured and the project can be commissioned thereafter. She concluded the arguments and requested the Commission to pass an appropriate Order in the matter.
3. Mr. S. P. Patel appearing for the Respondent No. 1 DGVCL submitted that as per the directions contained in the Daily Order dated 02.08.2025, the Respondent DGVCL has submitted the inspection/ verification report of the status of two solar projects of the Petitioner for which extension of time is sought in the present matter. He submitted that the Respondent DGVCL has already filed its Reply in the matter and requested the Commission to decide the Petition accordingly.
4. Mr. Shobraj Jaiswal appearing for Respondent No. 2 has submitted that the Respondent No. 2 GETCO has already filed its report stating that two solar projects of the Petitioner are connected at 11 kV networks of

Respondent No. 1 DGVCL and Bank Guarantee etc. is also sought by Respondent No. 1 and the role of Respondent No. 2 GETCO is limited to grant of technical feasibility at given substation only.

5. Heard the parties. We note that the Petitioner and Respondents have completed their arguments in the matter and requested time to file their respective written submissions, let it be filed within 3 days with a copy to other parties. The matter is now reserved for appropriate Order.
6. Order accordingly.
