DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 16.09.2025.
2. Shri Chetan Bundela, on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted that the present Petition has been filed in compliance to the directions issued by the Commission in its Order dtd. 29th March, 2025 in the matter of Truing up of FY 2023-24, Determination of ARR &

Tariff for FY 2025-26 to FY 2029-30 for Gujarat Energy Transmission Corporation Limited (GETCO) on the following issues;

- i. Non-compliance of OA Regulations regarding recovery of ARR pertaining to dedicated network from the beneficiaries of such dedicated network
 - ii. Recovery of additional transmission losses in case of Dholera SIR contrary to GERC Open Access Regulations
3. He further submitted that after the issuance of the afore-said Tariff Order, a letter had been sent to M/s GETCO for necessary action and subsequently, the Petitioner has filed miscellaneous petition, pursuant to the directions of the Commission seeking for determination of transmission charges and losses payable by TPL-D after deducting ARR expenses pertaining to dedicated network and give adjustment of over recovery of Transmission loss from TPL-Dholera. He further submitted that last week, the soft copy of the petition has been provided to the Respondent.
4. Shri Aneesh Bajaj, on behalf of the Respondent, submitted that it has received their soft copy of the petition last week. He has further submitted that it requires some time to file its reply.
5. Heard the parties. The Respondent sought time to file reply in the present matter. Let the same be filed by the Respondent within 7 days, with a copy to the Petitioner. Thereafter, The Petitioner is at liberty to file rejoinder in reply, if any, within two days from the date of receipt of reply.
6. The matter is kept for further hearing on 30th September, 2025.
