**Addendum to Daily Order dated 09.06.21022 in Petition No. 2098 of 2022.**

**Petition under Section 86 read with Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for approval of deviations from the Guidelines issued by Central Government for procurement of power through Tariff based Competitive Bidding Process from Grid connected Renewable Energy Sources i.e., Wind, Solar and Wind-Solar Hybrid Projects and for approval of bid documents for carrying out bidding process for procurement of power from Hybrid Power Projects having RE generation with co-located Energy Storage Systems.**

The Commission has passed Daily Order dated 09.06.2022 in the present matter pursuant to hearing held on 07.06.2022 wherein although the submission of the Petitioner has been recorded that the Commission may in the interim allow the Petitioner to issue tender so that consultative process, pre-bid conference etc. can be initiated and the Petitioner will open the tender after the Commission accords its approval to deviations and the Draft Bidding Documents in accordance to the deviations as may be approved. During the said hearing considering the aforesaid submissions of the Petitioner, the Commission had orally approved that the Petitioner in the meanwhile may proceed further by issuing the said tender but inadvertently, the said decision of the Commission is not recorded in the aforesaid Daily Order. Hence, following para is added after para 3.4 and accordingly, para 3.5 in above Daily Order to be renumbered as 3.6:

3.5 We note that during the hearing the Petitioner has requested that the Commission may in the interim allow the Petitioner to issue tender so that

*consultative process, pre-bid conference etc. can be initiated and the Petitioner will open the tender after the Commission accords its approval to deviations and the Draft Bidding Documents in accordance to the deviations as may be approved. Accordingly, we decide that the Petitioner may issue tender so that consultative process & other aspects can be undertaken. However, we make it clear that the same shall be subject to final decision of this Commission in the present matter.*
