ORAL ORDER

1. **Rule.** Learned APP waives service of Rule on behalf of the respondent-State.
2. By way of this application the applicant convict prays for being released on parole leave for the purpose of providing financial assistance to his family.
3. Jail remarks would show that the applicant has been convicted for offence punishable under Section 302 etc. of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo life years imprisonment and whereas the applicant appears to have undergone approximately 16 years and 10 months imprisonment. Jail remarks would also show that the applicant had been lastly released on furlough leave in the month of July, 2022 and on parole leave in the month of November, 2022. The jail remarks would also show that as and when the applicant had been released earlier, he had scrupulously surrendered in time.
4. Considering the above aspect and considering the period of



incarceration undergone and having regard to the fact that as and when the applicant had been released earlier, he had surrendered in time, this Court is inclined to consider the present application. Hence, the applicant is directed to be released on parole leave for a period of **30 Days (Thirty Days)** from the date of his actual release on executing personal bond of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand)** before the Jail authority and on usual terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Jail Authority.

5. The applicant convict shall surrender before Jail Authority on completion of parole leave, without fail. Rule is made absolute to the aforesaid extent.

6. Registry is directed to communicate this order to the concerned jail authorities by fax/email forthwith.
