IA ORDER

1. Rule. Learned APP waives service of notice of Rule for and on behalf of respondent - State.

2. This application is filed by the applicant seeking extension of period of temporary bail granted by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 11.11.2022 passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.20378 of 2022 on the ground of his medical treatment.

3. Heard learned advocate Ms. G. R. Vijayalakshmi for the applicant and learned APP Ms. Mehta for the respondent - State.

4. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that

initially the application for temporary bail has been granted by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 11.11.2022 and the same has been extended from time to time on the ground of illness of the applicant. She, therefore, requested that the present application may be allowed and the period of temporary bail be extended for a long time considering the illness of the applicant.

5. Learned APP Ms. Mehta has fairly submitted that looking to the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court may pass an appropriate order.

6. I have considered the submissions canvassed by learned advocates appearing for the respective parties. I have also perused the orders passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court releasing the applicant on temporary bail as well as extending the period of temporary bail from time to time. I have also perused the medical papers produced on record and I am of the opinion that the period of temporary bail granted by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 11.11.2022 passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.20378 of 2022, is required to be extended for a further period of four weeks. Accordingly, the same is extended for a further period of **four weeks** on the same terms and conditions. The original accused shall surrender before the the Jail Authority on completion of the

aforesaid temporary release period, without fail.

7. Rule is made absolute to the aforesaid extent.
