On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:

“Case has been called out several times since morning. None has put in appearance. Let fresh notice be issued to the appellant for 26.07.2023. A representative of the appellant-company duly authorised by its Managing Director to appear in person before this Tribunal on the next date of hearing.”

Today an adjournment slip has been moved on behalf of counsel for the appellant on the ground that he cannot appear before this Tribunal due to some unavoidable circumstances.

No representative of the appellant company, as directed in the last order, is present.

It is pertinent to mention that earlier the case was dismissed in default due to non-appearance on behalf of the appellant on 12.12.2022. It was later restored. As there is consistent appearance default on part of the appellant, we are not inclined to grant any adjournment.

Purely, in the interests of justice, the case is adjourned to 31.08.2023 subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- as costs. Same be deposited with Poor Patients' Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh. Receipt thereof be produced well before the next date of hearing.
