Recovery certificate was issued to the Collector, Gurugram in this case to recover decretal amount from JD as arrears of land revenue. As per Ld. counsel for DH, no amount has been recovered through Collector, Gurugram. This fact is admitted by Ld. counsel for JD also.

Ld. counsel for DH request to attach two bank accounts of JD, details of which is well given in the application filed today.


According to Ld. counsel for JD, his client is ready to make payment of decretal amount as per recovery certificate, the payment in 9 installments is not acceptable to DH. He insists to attach the bank accounts of JD.

Request is allowed.

Let bank accounts of JD are attached to the extent of decretal amount. Managers of said banks be directed not to allow withdrawal of any amount from these accounts leaving balance less than decretal amount. As per DH two bank accounts mentioned at Sr. No. 2 & 3 are not escrow accounts. Let a copy of this order be sent to the bank managers concerned for compliance, their report be called till next date.
