On previous date, JD was directed to disclose its assets/properties including bank account and unsold inventories, which can be attached to realize the decretal amount by filing an affidavit to be sworn by anyone from its directors, preferably by Managing Director. No such affidavit is filed.

An application is filed on behalf of JD. It is submitted by learned counsel representing the same submits that JD has account no 777705226266 with ICICI Bank, Legal Building, Parliament Street Branch, New Delhi and there is balance of about of Rs. 60.00 crore in this account. Learned counsel has no objection if this account is attached to realize decretal amount. Fresh calculation is filed by learned counsel for DH. According to it, a sum of Rs. 48,13,463/- is payable by JD as on today. Considering all these, bank account of JD as mentioned above is attached to the extent of decretal amount, referred above. Manager of said bank be directed to deduct aforesaid amount from the account of JD and to remit to the account of authority, so that same can be disbursed to the DH.
