

34. Babu Lal Poddar vs Kashish Developers E/5992/2019



Recovery certificate was issued in this matter to the Collector, Gurugram on 10.02.2023, to recover decretal amount as arrears of land revenue. In view of order/circular issued by Chief Secretary Government of Haryana, no. 50/15/20240-5S (1) dated 11th May 2024, powers of the Collector have been conferred upon the Adjudicating Officers and all the recovery certificates have been received back.

As per learned counsel for DH, no amount has been recovered through Collector till now. He requests to resume execution proceedings. Considering the above facts, request is allowed, and execution proceedings are resumed.

It is pointed out that JD was also directed in this matter to disclose its assets/properties including bank account which can be attached to realize the decretal amount, but no such affidavit was filed. Show cause notices were issued against directors of JD as why same be not committed to civil prison for not handing over possession. No reply is filed by the directors of JD despite service upon Mukesh Kumar, Ajit Kumar Choudhary and Dhananjay Kumar Singh, all stated to be directors of JD. As requested by learned counsel for DH, issue arrest warrants against said Directors of JD to be executable by the bailiff of the Authority ^{file} for next date. Said directors be taken into custody and be produced before this Forum on or before next date.
