

8. Rajni vs M/s. Neo Developers Pvt Ltd E/5032/2023

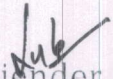
Present : Mr. Ganesh, Advocate for DH.

On previous date, JD was directed to disclose its assets/properties including bank account and unsold inventories which can be attached to realize the decretal amount by filing an affidavit to be sworn by anyone from its directors preferably by Managing Director, till today. No such affidavit is filed.

According to learned counsel for JD, his client is ready to pay decretal amount in 3 equated monthly instalments. Payment schedule is given in this regard Rs. 4,00,000/- 1st installments, Rs. 4,00,000/-(2nd instalments) and Rs. 5,48,767/- 3rd instalments. As per learned counsel for JD, this is the entire decretal amount.

A cheque for a sum of Rs. 4,00,000/- (first instalments) is handed over to learned counsel for DH, who accepts the same as part payment.

To come on 12.08.2025 remaining payment for further proceedings.
