In the meanwhile, substantive sentence imposed by learned Special Judge (CBI) Shimla, District Shimla, Himachal Pradesh, in Cr. Appeal No.1-S/7 of 2019, is suspended, subject to the appellant's furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court within a period of four weeks with the conditions that the appellant shall appear in the Court as and when directed and shall surrender to serve out the sentence imposed in case his appeal is ultimately dismissed. This order is further subject to the appellant depositing the entire amount of fine, if not already deposited, within a period of two weeks before the trial Court. Since the appellant is behind the bars, he be released forthwith.
