In terms of the judgment passed by the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Manali, District Kullu, (learned Trial Court), which was affirmed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kullu, District Kullu (learned Appellate Court) on 28.02.2023, against the total liability of Rs.15,00,000,- [Rupees Fifteen Lakh], Mr. Kainthla, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an amount of Rs.3,75,000/-[Rupees Three Lakh Seventy Five Thousand] has been deposited before the learned Trial Court.

2. That being so, the outstanding liability of the petitioner is Rs.11,25,000/- [Rupees Eleven Lakh Twenty Five Thousand] as on day. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to discharge his liability in case some additional time is granted.

In order to examine this aspect, let the petitioner appear before this Court on **18.03.2024**.
