THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO CALL FOR THE RECORDS FROM THE RESPONDENT ABOUT ANNEX-G AND GRANT THE FOLLOWING RELIEFS AND QUASHING THE IMPUGNED ENDORSEMENT DTD 24.07.2023 VIDE ANNEX-G ISSUED BY THE R-1 SINCE THE SAME IS ARBITRARY ILLEGAL AND CONTRARY TO THE ARTICLE -14 AND 19 (1)(G) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA AND ETC.,

THIS PETITION COMING ON FOR PERLIMINARY HEARING IN B GROUP THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

ORDER

The principal prayers of the petition read as under:

“(i) **ISSUE A WRIT OF CERTIORARI** or any other appropriate writ or order or directions, quashing the impugned endorsement bearing no. ಕಂಇ 7 ಮುಆಬಿ 2023 ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು dated 24.07.2023 vide Annexure-G issued by the 1st Respondent since the same is arbitrary, illegal and contrary to Articles-14 and 19 (1)(g) of the Constitution of India.

(ii) **ISSUE A WRIT OF MANDAMUS** or any other appropriate writ or order or directions, directing the 1st Respondent to consider the representation dated 09.08.2023 submitted by the Petitioner to extend the lease



period till the disposal of SLP(Civil) No.8361/2021, SLP(Civil) No.11925/2021 and SLP(Civil) No.11928/2021 pending on the file of Hon'ble Apex Court the copy of representation is marked as Annexure-H and."

2. The subject matter of this petition is substantially similar to the one in W.P.No.18106/2023 between J.VIJAYAKUMAR vs. STATE & OTHERS disposed off by this court today with a cost quantified at 10% of the amount due to the respondent-temple, this petition also has to meet the same fate.

Ordered accordingly and writ petition is dismissed with a cost payable to the respondent-temple quantified at 10% of the amount due. Cost to be remitted within 30 days. All other conditions as incorporated in the cognate case also will be applicable.
