The State says that despite best efforts the work order could not be issued since the lowest bidder may have relied on fabricated documents and the tender committee is looking into the matter.

Whatever may be the situation, the process has to be expedited.

As for the temporary arrangements for a Bailey bridge, it is submitted that because of the heavy rains, the support structure to hold the Bailey bridge could not be put in place and it is hoped that even a short respite from the rains may allow the Bailey bridge to be constructed.

While the Court appreciates the difficulty faced in the monsoon season, yet it cannot be accepted that far-flung places would be without access and the rains would be an excuse for not being able to connect such places.

Let the matter stand over for a fortnight. Expeditious and effective decisions ought to be taken so that the suffering of the local people can be alleviated at the earliest.
