In terms of judgment dated 28.06.2018 passed in WP(C) No. 363 of 2016, the respondent BSNL was under command to settle and release the pensionary benefits in favour of respondent No. 2 in accordance with the Rules within six weeks, same has not happened, hence the instant motion on behalf of respondent BSNL for extension of two months' time to enable the department to comply with the direction.

In the application, it is stated that BSNL has taken various steps for settling the case of the petitioner. Steps as taken are reflected in paragraph 5 of the application.

In view of the seriousness shown and steps taken coupled with the fact of filing the application seeking extension, which in turn also shows there is seriousness in settling the pension case of the petitioner, two months' time as a last opportunity is granted for ensuring compliance of the judgment with a condition that no further extension will be granted.
