1. Heard Ms. A.Paul, learned ASG for the applicants who submits that the present contract with the respondent is going to expire on 30-06-2018 and there is shortage of ration for the jawans, hence, this instant vacation petition. She also submits that until this stay is vacated, there may be food crises in the Assam Rifles, so necessary order may be passed.

2. On the other hand, Mr. S.C.Chakrawarty, learned Sr. counsel assisted by Mr. S.Saraogi, learned counsel appeared for the respondents and submits that he has no objection if temporary arrangement is made but the tender process should not be finalized until the writ petition is heard and disposed of. He also referred to Clause 52 of the tender agreement (contract agreement).

3. After hearing both the learned counsels for the parties and applying my mind, I hereby order and modify my earlier order dated 21-05-2018 to the extent that applicants will be at liberty to extend the previous contract to meet the exigency or can make some other alternative arrangement with



any other dealers as they wish. However, the tender in question will not be finalized till the outcome of the writ petition.
