In continuation to our earlier orders dated 28.05.2024, 21.06.2024 and 15.07.2024, we would like to clarify that the court had specifically expressed its view to visit Bhutan, so as to have an idea as to how bigger flights are being operated in such a small Airport and what are the facilities made available for safer landing and taking off therein. The purpose of visit of the Hon'ble Judges and the Officials of Meghalaya High Court is to ascertain the possibility of adopting the same *modus operandi* being followed in Bhutan in order to facilitate larger/sizeable

Aircrafts to land and take off in the Shillong Airport without any difficulty.

The word ‘inspection’ found in our earlier orders does not mean an inspection of an Airport in a different Country. It is only a visit to know the feasibility of mid-size aircraft landing and taking off at a smaller Airport.
