The appeal is directed against an order dated June 22, 2015 passed by the Director General of Border Security Force, dismissing an appeal against an order of December 10, 2013 of the General Security Force Court by which the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to suffer life imprisonment and was also dismissed from service.

The matter has to be heard by a Division Bench in terms of Rule 6 of Chapter V of the Meghalaya High Court Rules.

Since the trial was conducted by the General Security Force Court, the petitioner seeks inspection of the records of the trial. Subject to any restriction in such regard under the applicable rules, due inspection of the records should be given to Advocate for the petitioner with liberty to make reasonable copies of such records as may be necessary.

Affidavit-in-opposition be filed within two weeks after the vacation; reply thereto, if any, may be filed within a week thereafter.

Let the matter appear six weeks after the vacation.
