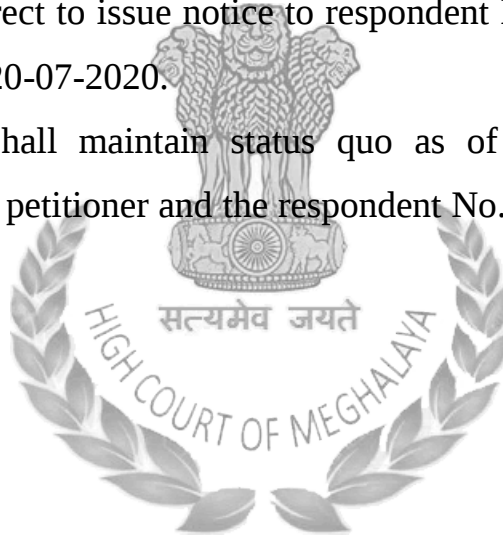


Likewise respondent No.3 is also required remain in quarantine in Daddengre. The learned counsel further submits that there is policy of the Government that normally government servant be allowed to complete tenure of 3 years at one place. The learned counsel undertakes to place this policy on record before next date of hearing.

Mr. B. Bhattacharjee, learned AAG appearing for the respondent Nos. 1-4 submits that the impugned transfer order is in public interest. There are no mala-fide alleged and, therefore, this Court should not interfere transfer order. He also submits that there is no policy of the Government which prohibits the transfer of the government servant within the period of 3 years. Learned AAG also wants to place his affidavit-in-reply on record. He seeks some time for that purpose.

Accordingly, in the light of the above I pass following orders: -

1. Registry is direct to issue notice to respondent No.5. Notice is made returnable to 20-07-2020.
2. The parties shall maintain status quo as of today regarding the transfer of the petitioner and the respondent No.5 under the impugned order.
