Issue notice.

Mr. N.D. Chullai, learned AAG assisted by Ms. Z.E. Nongkynrih, learned GA is present and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1, 5, 6 and 7, as such, no further notice is called for upon these respondents.

As the matter seems to be of some urgency, the petitioner is permitted in the course of the day to effect personal service upon the official respondents No. 2 and 3 and service also by registered A/D upon the respondents No. 4 and 8.

The grievance of the writ petitioner who is stated to be the Lyngdoh of Raid Myllem is that the upcoming religious event that is “Ka Leh Niam Raid Myllem” which is scheduled to be performed on 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 till 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2025, is sought to be stopped by the respondent No. 8, who is stated to be the Myntri of Hima Myllem.

Mr. N. Syngkon, learned counsel has also submitted that the petitioner is also fearful that he might be removed from his post. Accordingly, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken by the concerned respondents against the petitioner.
