Mr. K.Paul, learned Sr. counsel for the respondents at the outset having taken instruction from his client makes a statement that the outstanding dues of electricity amounting to ₹ 33,82,291/- (Rupees Thirty-three Lakhs, Eighty-two thousand, two hundred and ninety-one) approximately shall be deposited with the petitioner in two equal instalments. First instalment would be paid within the period of one week from today and second instalment will be paid within seven days after the first instalment. Statement accepted as undertaking before this Court.

The above statement is accepted without going into the merits of the petition. The issue raised by the petitioner regarding payment of DPC and interest charges is kept specifically open. The respondents, in addition to the above said arrears of dues, shall go on paying the current dues of electricity regularly.

Mr. A.Kumar, learned AG agrees that after payment of first instalment, the petitioner will restore the supply of electricity connection to the respondents.
