- (i) The respondent No.2 is directed to decide the Representation dated 05-08-2019 copy of which annexed at ANNEXURE – II – A as expeditiously as possible and in any case within the period of 4 (four) weeks from the date of the receipt of this order.
- (ii) It is made clear that, I have not gone into the merits of the matter and the respondent No.2 (Collector/ Deputy commissioner) shall decide the said representation on its own merits and in accordance with law.
- (ii) Needless to mention, that the said representation shall be disposed of after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and respondent No.3.



In order to comply this order, the petitioner shall remain present before the respondent No.2 along with the copy of this order and copy of the said representation on 14-12-2020.
