From the file it appears that the matter has been settled in the Lok Adalat on 08-09-2018. Copy of the Award is also attached to the file. If it is so, there survives nothing to be addressed by this Court as settlement before the Lok Adalat attains the finality as per Section 21 of the ***Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987*** which is reproduced herein below:

“21. Award of Lok Adalat: [(1) Every award of the Lok Adalat shall be deemed to be a decree of a Civil Court or, as the case may be, an order of any other Court and where a compromise or settlement has been arrived at, by a Lok Adalat in a case referred to it under sub-section (1) of section 20, the Court-fee paid in such case shall be refunded in the manner provided under the Court-Fees Act, 1870 (7 of 1870).]

(2) Every award made by a Lok Adalat shall be final and binding on all the parties to the dispute, and no appeal shall lie to any Court against the award.”



Learned counsel for the respondent No. 1, Mr. K.Khan also pointed to the release of the pensionary benefits within 30-06-2019.

Matter stands disposed of.
