1. Heard Mr. R.Jha, learned counsel for the petitioners and Dr. N.Mozika, learned ASG for the respondents.

2. The three petitioners in pursuant to advertisement published on 21-07-2018, applied for the post of Constable (GD) in Central Armed Police Forces. Though the petitioners possessed the requisite qualification, they were found to be medically unfit in the initial medical examination and therefore were not selected. In pursuant to the petitioners' application, review medical examination was also done. In this review medical examination also, petitioners were found to be unfit.

3. This Court in exercise of writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution, cannot give direction to the respondents to select the petitioners despite the fact that they were found to be medically unfit. Petition is devoid of merit and is therefore dismissed.
