Per Ajay Kumar Mittal, 'CJ': (ORAL):

1. Challenge in this writ petition filed by the Meghalaya Commercial Truck Owners and Operators Association is to Rule 10 of the Meghalaya Installation, Regulation, Maintenance and Operation of Weighbridge Rules, 2009 prescribing weighment fee for goods vehicles purportedly under Section 138 (b) of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and enhancement of weighment fees vide the Meghalaya Installation, Regulation, Maintenance and Operation of Weighbridge Rules, 2015 published vide notification bearing No.TPT.40/97/Pt/360 dated 20.01.2015. It has also been prayed that the imposition of compulsory weighment fee on goods vehicles on the strength of the Meghalaya Installation, Regulation, Maintenance and Operation of Weighbridge Rules 2009 and also Notice Inviting Tender bearing No.Com/Trans/T/WB/70/2012/273 dated 03.08.2018 be struck down.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that during the pendency of this writ petition, new developments have taken place. Accordingly, he prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh writ petition on the cause of action surviving.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
