Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In course of hearing, Mr. K.P. Bhattacharjee, learned GA for the State respondent Nos. 1-4, has led this Court to the affidavit-in-opposition filed on 14.09.2022 on behalf of the respondent No. 3, wherein in the latter part of para 18 at page 19, mention has been made as regard the selection process which was carried out by the relevant authority where the post occupied earlier by the petitioner was advertised, and it was also averred that the petitioner was allowed to participate in the said selection process.

However, the learned counsel for the petitioner has categorically stated that the petitioner has no knowledge of such selection process as far as filling up of the said post is concerned, except the fact that she was called to complete her Meghalaya Teacher Eligibility Test (MTET) examination.

Be that as it may, since this Court need clarity on the issue, the State respondent is called upon to file an additional affidavit to clarify the same. The said affidavit to be filed within the next date fixed, and in the meantime, advance copy of the same to be issued upon the petitioner, who will file the rejoinder affidavit, if so advised. Both the said affidavits to be brought on record within the next date fixed, considering the fact that this case has proceeded for quite some time.
