ORAL:-

1. The case set up by the petitioner is that on expiry of the term of outgoing Managing Committee in the month of February 2018 a new Managing Committee was elected, the petitioner is the Secretary of the Committee. The Managing Committee so elected was submitted to the higher authorities for approval, till date no approval has been received instead a communication has been issued by the District School Education Officer, East Khasi Hills District, Shillong dated 07.08.2018 in terms whereof, the Headmaster of Garo Union Secondary School, Shillong has been asked to explore the possibility to re-constitute the Managing Committee thereafter, according to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has taken up the matter with respondent No. 3, who has not so far taken any decision but meanwhile, apprehend that the functioning of the present Managing Committee is likely to be disturbed hence, the instant petition.

2. The petition on the face of it is not maintainable because the Managing Committee so elected is yet to be approved. For redressal of the grievance petitioner has taken up the matter with respondent No. 3 without waiting for the result thereof, has filed the instant petition. Suffice it to say that respondent No. 3 shall consider the representation filed by the



petitioner dated 13.06.2018 and pass appropriate order thereon in accordance with law preferably within a period of three weeks.

3. With the aforesaid observations, petition being not maintainable shall accordingly stand disposed of.

4. Disposed of as above.
