Mr. S.A. Sheikh, learned counsel appeared on behalf of the petitioner, Mr. N.D. Chullai, learned Addl. AG assisted by Mr. A. Kharwanlang, learned GA appeared on behalf of the State respondent No. 1-3 and Mr. R. Debnath, learned CGC appeared on behalf of the respondent No. 4.

Office note dated 19.03.2019 indicates that para-wise comments from the Additional Director, Community & Rural Development has been sent to the Registrar (Judicial), which is highly improper and not as per court procedure.
