Heard Mr. R.Kar, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr S.Dey, learned counsel for the respondents-GHADC.

After hearing the learned counsels for the parties, I am of the considered view that this instant writ petition is not maintainable. There is an alternative remedy available before the Public Premises Act or Subordinate Courts.

Petitioner is directed to approach the appropriate courts but not in any manner by way of writ. Petitioner is at liberty to approach the appropriate courts within 15(fifteen) days from the date of this order.

Learned counsel for the respondents-GHADC is asked for the next 15(fifteen) days, not to disturb the petitioner to avail the chance to file or assail his grievances before the competent authority.

Matter stands dismissed and disposed of.
