1. Heard.

2. The petitioner claimed to be the Sordar of village Mynniar-B, West Khasi Hills District, Meghalaya. The name of the petitioner appears at Sl. No. 116 in a draft voter list published in December, 2020 for the election of Syiem (Chief) of Myriaw Syiemship. The grievance of the petitioner is that when the final voter-list was published, his name was deleted.

3. Mr. V. G. K. Kynta, learned Senior Counsel for respondent No.1 to 3 at the outset submits that the election of Syiem (Chief) of Myriaw Syiemship is scheduled to be held tomorrow i.e. 24-02-2021. He submits that petitioner has approached the Court very late and, therefore, this Court should not intervene in the petition. He further submits that the petitioner claimed to be the Sordar of Village Mynniar – B, however, there is no such village in existence and, therefore, name of the petitioner was deleted from the final voter-list.

4. At this stage, Mr. H. R. Nath, learned counsel for the petitioner having



taken instruction from his client seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to file election petition challenging the election of Myriaw Syiem.

5. Both, Mr. V. G. K. Kynta, learned senior counsel for respondents No.1 – 3 and Mr. P. Nongbri, learned counsel for respondent No. 4 have no objection in this regard.

6. In above circumstances, leave granted to the petitioner to withdraw the petition with liberty to file election petition to challenge the election of the Syiem (Chief) of Myriaw syiemship, in accordance with law.

7. It is made clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter, all points and contention of the respective parties kept open expressly.

8. Petition disposed of.
