ORDER

1. In terms of the order dated 04.04.2025, the DDA has filed the status report dated 06.08.2025. Learned counsel for the DDA referring to the judgement dated 30.05.2025 passed by the Single Bench of High Court Delhi in W.P.(C) No. 3656/2024 in the matter of Ravi Ranjan Singh v. Delhi Development Authority has submitted that the pending writ petition wherein the stay was operating has now been dismissed. She submits thereafter the public notice of demolition drive against the encroachment were issued and the communication dated 14.07.2025 was sent to the Police for extending assistance and by the reply dated 14.07.2025 (page 1153) the Police Authorities had expressed inability to extend help on account of ongoing Kavar Yatra. The said communication also contains the following request of Deputy Commissioner of Police:-

“It is, therefore, requested that the above said demolition programme may kindly be carried out after joint survey, planning and coordination meeting with all the stakeholders to assess the requirement/logistic and assessment by Special Branch to evaluate the ground situation.”

2. Learned counsel appearing for the DDA has sought four weeks' time to examine the above request and do the needful. The prayer is allowed.
