ORDER

1. In this Original Application, the grievance of the applicant is that the dying factories are operating without consent/NOC/permission in Bindapur, Matiala, Ranhola, Khyala, Meethapur, Badarpur and Kirar, Delhi. The Tribunal by order dated 23.05.2023 had called for a joint report of CPCB and DPCC in respect of the units named by the applicant and had also issued notice in the OA.

2. In the action taken report dated 03.10.2023, the tabulated information in respect of the joint visit to 18 units was disclosed and the said chart reveals that some of the units were found locked, some were already sealed and in other units, no jeans dying factory was found. Subsequently, the action taken report dated 28.11.2023 was filed again reflecting the status of 16 remaining premises/locations and the said chart also discloses the same position in respect of the remaining units as was disclosed earlier. In yet another report dated 30.01.2024, the

status of 10 remaining premises/locations was disclosed in the same manner.

3. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the dying units are still continuing in the areas concerned and seeks time to file objection to the report disclosing therein in the tabular form, the status of respondent-Project Proponent and the details of operation of dying units by them.
