However, within prescribed time as per the order dated 24.05.2022 of the Tribunal, no additional reply/ response has been filed by either of these two respondents and therefore they are clearly in defiance of the orders of Tribunal and has committed *prima-facie* an offence under Section 26 of National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.

2. Let Chief Executive Officer, Noida and Greater Noida, both, should appear before Tribunal day after tomorrow to show cause as to why for non-compliance of Tribunal's order dated 25.04.2024, appropriate criminal prosecution may not be initiated against them for committing an offence under Section 26 of NGT Act, 2010.

3. Put up day after tomorrow 09.08.2024.
