ORDER

1. Mr. Gaurav Kumar son of Mr. Kailash Kumar resident of H.No.218-A Railway Colony, Yamuna Nagar has sent present letter petition complaining that M/s Star Mines was given mining lease for mining of sand, bajri and boulders from the mining site in Village Bhartha, Korsi, Tehsil Behat, District Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh, without replenishment

study and CTO, CTE and without NOC from CGWA regarding which ***Appeal No.15/2021 Titled as Pramod Vs. State of U.P. and others,*** was filed before this Tribunal. This Tribunal had constituted Joint Committee vide order dated 09.06.2021 and in compliance of order of this Tribunal Report had been filed. In view of the irregularities, this Tribunal, vide order dated 10.05.2022, imposed compensation of 11 crores which has not been deposited. The above said company is illegally carrying on mining activities with heavy machinery in the river bed and has thereby even diverted natural flow of river Yamuna thereby creating risk of flood in the area of Haryana.

2. We are of the opinion that the Tribunal having passed order, if the applicant has any grievance, it may move the concerned authority. We do not find it appropriate to act on a letter in such matter.

The Application is disposed of accordingly.
