ORDER

1. In this execution application, the applicant is seeking compliance of the order dated 18.01.2023 passed in O.A. No. 329/2021.
2. The compliance affidavit dated 24.03.2025 has been filed by Agra Development Authority (ADA). Learned Counsel appearing for the ADA, referring to the chart enclosed as annexure P-8 page 243, has submitted that the tankers are employed to lift the sewage, but in this chart, the frequency of operation of those tankers have not been disclosed, and this chart only relates to the period from 17.01.2025 to 26.01.2025.
3. Learned Counsel for the ADA has also referred to annexure P-10 at page 274, and has submitted that a contract has been entered into for

lifting the sewage from Nalanda Town Rajrai Road but a perusal of that contract reveals that it relates to the lifting of waste water of the STP to some other STP. The Vice Chairman, ADA, appearing virtually, has submitted that there is a typographical error in said contract.

4. The Vice Chairman, ADA appearing virtually has also submitted that there is some defect in the construction of STP and the said STP is of 200 KLD capacity and the contract is being awarded for the maintenance of the STP. If the STP suffers from any construction defect then it is required to be identified and rectified.

5. The Vice Chairman will disclose in the next affidavit the steps taken in this regard and also the timeline for completing the entire process for ensuring that the STP functions as per the norms and brought in line with approved design.
